#### Who are we?

KISS is a confidential Sexual Health and Well-Being service that provides advice and information to young people aged 13-19 who go to school or live in London Borough of Hillingdon.

#### What do we offer?

The KISS team can provide information and support on topics including:

### **Healthy Relationships:**

- Understanding consent and boundaries
- Appropriate and inappropriate sexual behaviours
- Signposting for further support

#### Sexual Health

- Information on where to access STI screenings.
- Advice on preventing STIs.

#### Contraception

- Information about different types of contraception available and where to access this.
- Access to free condoms via the C-card scheme (\*We provide this service to all under 25s)
- Advice on where to access emergency contraception. (\*We do not provide emergency contraception)

#### **Pregnancy Testing**

- Access to free pregnancy testing.
- Information and support around pregnancy choices.

#### Sexuality and Identity

- Information on LGBT+ groups that are running.
- Signposting to further support services.
