WHAT IS WOOD END PARK'S SPECIALIST UNIT?

- The Unit will be attached to Wood End Park's mainstream provision but the children will have their own space to learn and play;
- There will be 24 children in total in the Unit, all with Autistic Spectrum Condition;
- There will be a higher ratio of staff to children than in mainstream provision;
- The Unit will be opening in January 2024.
- The Unit will aim to support with child to make progress in their academics as well as with their language and social skills.

WHAT TYPE OF SUPPORT WILL MY CHILD GET?

- The staff within the Unit will all have specialist training on how to best support young learners with Autism;
- We will also receive support from various external agencies including Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy and Educational Psychologists should your child require this support.

FURTHER INFORMATION

- The Unit will be located on the site of Wood End Park Academy, Judge Heath Lane, UB3 2PD;
- Hillingdon Transport can be applied for to support your child with getting to and from school;
- Visits will be arranged and carried out by the Vice Principal, Lily Claridge, to see if we can meet your child's needs within the provision. The information regarding your child will have been sent to the Vice Principal from your Hillingdon Case Officer.
