Entry requirements

No formal qualifications are required to join the programme. Learning Support is integral.

Course content

The programme offers participants the opportunity to build confidence and gain new skills in a supportive, informal environment. Participants will be engaged in:

- Team building residential trip
- Community Project; contributing to the local community
- Work Placement
- Team Challenge; Caring for others
- Practical & Creative workshops
- Team Presentation

You will gain

- **Prince's Trust Level 1 or 2 Certificate In Employment, Teamwork and Community Skills**

(QCF)

Learners produce a portfolio of evidence that is presented to claim the qualification. Learners will cover topics like:

- Community Project
- Teamwork
- Presentation Skills
- Work experience
- Career Planning
- Planning for Personal Development
- Supporting Others in the Community

Study methods

Learners keep a diary of the activities they participate in a portfolio. At the end of the programme, this is presented as evidence for the qualification.

How the course is assessed

Portfolios are assessed throughout the course of the programme. Internal and External Verification occurs on completion.

- **Study:** Better preparation for college courses, guidance and support in making the next step.
- **Job Opportunities:** Better preparation for entry into the job market. Increasing learners' confidence and developing practical strategies to help you find employment.
- **Training & Apprenticeship:** Better preparation for entry into further training and vocational apprenticeship.
